

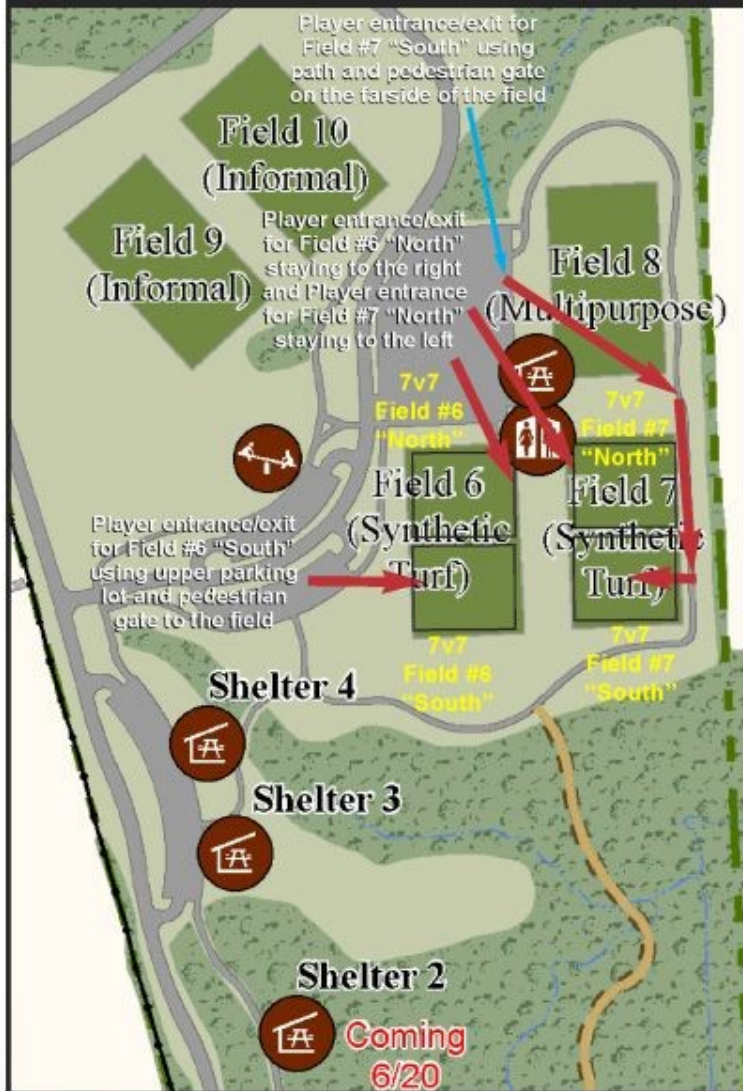
COVID 7v7 SUMMER LEAGUE POLICIES

Participants must follow Frederick County's COVID-19 "Return to Play" Protocols (Below) or be dismissed from the event.

Individuals with any of the following are prohibited from participating or attending: sick/don't feel well; have a temperature; at risk because of age or underlying medical condition; exposed to virus.

When a player attends SiSL games, their presence affirms the following:

- (a) they feel well, are in good health, and have no COVID-19 symptoms;
- (b) they do not have a fever; and
- (c) they have not been exposed to anyone with the virus

- Be respectful of Physical Distancing monitors if asked about spacing issues.
- Face Coverings will be worn by staff and athletes when not playing consistent with Maryland Strong Roadmap to Recovery Guidance.
- Players should go to the bathroom before arriving to training/games. There is no guarantee that restrooms will be available for players.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be provided.
- Entry & Exit points are located on the map for each field with RED arrows.
- DO NOT enter the field until the previous group has completely vacated the area.
- High fives, hand shakes, etc. will be suspended during the league.
- Players will be required to place their soccer bags 6' at a minimum apart from each other next to the field.
- Players will NOT be permitted share any water and/or equipment.
- League staff or coaches ONLY will sanitize and handle any equipment needed for the league such as soccer balls.
- Non-participant attendance should be kept minimal (family only) or non-existent.
- Attendance must be consistent with Maryland Strong Roadmap to Recovery Guidance.
- The allowable COVID capacity for Utica bleacher seating per field is 164.
- 6' physical distancing MUST be maintained between family groups.
- Those in the "at risk" categories, including those age 60+, should consider not attending.
- Additional family groups may spread out with 6' physical distancing around the plaza or outside the fences as long as the walkways are not obstructed.
